

## GASS COVID-19 GUIDELINES AND COWBOY RANGE INFORMATION

Get to range earlier than normal...process will take a bit more time.

**DO NOT** sign up anyone but yourself at registration.

We all want to shoot, so please follow guidelines herein. Shorter posses will take time to get through the match. Keep your distance! We are being watched.

• ***Registration will be held outside under the covered area next to the office,***

Starting ~8:30am - 9:30am

• Shooter's Meeting will be held at 9:30 a.m.

• Masks are recommended, but are not mandatory when shooting.

Make sure you do have your masks!

### Registration/General Safety/Safety Briefings

- Sign up registration will be one-on-one interactions. There will be a table outside under the covered area starting from the Pull Barn side; ONE shooter at a time will enter. Each shooter will then sign in on the ARPC Club sheet and then sign up on a Posse. All the while maintaining a 6 foot social distancing between shooters signing up. Once signed up, shooter will exit to the right (by office).
- We will have one of the directors or assigned assistant behind this table to ensure these guidelines are followed and wipe down pencils after used.
- Shooters will be required to wear facial covering; a mask or bandana at this time and throughout the day if closer than the 6 foot social distancing.
- Personal protective equipment to include masks, hand sanitizer will be the responsibility of each individual shooter as ***GASS is not providing***.
- NO individual will be allowed in the GASS office; exception will be for match director(s) to obtain supplies as timers; clipboards; pencils; scenarios for each stage on given day.
- Spotting sticks WILL NOT be utilized and not taken from office.
- Individuals WILL NOT be allowed in class room; exceptions will be given for such items that may need to be under refrigeration. And then only entering and maintaining 6 foot social distancing. Individuals will enter from office door proceed through and out class room door by restrooms.
- We WILL NOT put out any water dispensing jugs or cups. Individuals will need to bring their own beverages for the day. GASS may at times offer individual bottled water during extreme hot weather.
- Sharing of any foods WILL NOT be allowed.
- Safety briefings WILL include all COVID-19 restrictions, requirements and guidance to all attending for the days match such as:
  - Washing hands often
  - Avoiding close contact with people who are sick, and practicing social distancing
  - Covering mouth and nose with a cloth face cover when around others
  - Covering coughs and sneezes

## Posse Guidelines

- Posse Leaders will be selected.
- Posse limit will be no more than 10.
- Posse members must maintain 6 foot distancing at all times.
- Handling of another shooters firearms or supplies will be avoided whenever possible. In the event of firearm malfunction, keep firearm in owner's hands only. If assistance is needed, all necessary precautions must be taken. Ex: gloves, hand washing, sanitizer, etc.
- Spotting sticks **WILL NOT** be utilized. Posse leader will appoint some kind of identification. Ex: raised arm, etc.
- Timer will be designated for each posse. Rotate with **ONLY ONE** other posse member for timing/shooting purposes. Wiping down of timer will be done with sanitary wipes.
- Scorekeeper will be designated for each posse. Rotate with **ONLY ONE** other posse member for paper scoring/shooting purposes. Wiping down of pencil will be done with sanitary wipes, or more than one will be used. If electronic scoring tablets are used, all surfaces and score keeper(s) hands will need to use hand sanitary wipes or hand sanitary gel/spray.
- If targets need to be reset, designating as few as possible members of posse will be appointed.

## Time to Shoot

- Posse members will maintain 6 foot distance at all times.
- No more than 5 members on the firing line. (Shooter, TO and 3 spotters) All other shooters will remain behind barricades.
- There will be no more than 2 shooters at loading table for given time. As shooter is called to line, next shooter will come to loading table.
- Shooter may lower face covering while on clock while shooting as not to fog up safety glasses if needed...**this is a safety precaution only**. Once finished shooting, shooter will replace face covering. During the much warmer months, this will be a constant battle.
- When shooter is finished, will proceed to unloading table and unload firearms and get "all clear" by posse member stationed there.
- The timer will be disinfected between hand-offs to and from alternating timer operators.
- Designated brass pickers should use tools (pickers) to retrieve brass/hulls and generally avoid handling other shooters brass/hulls.

## End of Match

- Designated posse leader will turn in score sheets from each posse by placing on registration table.
- Match Director and assistants will make sure range has been cleared and all supplies, timers, etc. are put in office. Office will then be locked before leaving.
